

6 And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" 7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God." Gal 4:4-7 -As we enter into the season of Advent we remember our Lord's words from the Gospel of Mark when he began his Galilean ministry. Mark 1:14 "Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, 'the time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."

-As we await His Second Advent—Jesus IS coming again - the message still rings clear: Repent and believe in the Gospel and do the works!

"What Does Trinity Lutheran Church Mean to Me?"

Trinity was the first and only congregation I ever served as pastor. After only two years at Trinity, my first call out of the seminary, I was called to serve the church in a number of non-parish ministries over the years. Because I was never again a parish pastor, I am especially grateful that the Lord gave me those two years with the people of Trinity, Glen Cove.

Not only were the people warm and friendly toward Lois and me, but they were also very patient with me as a new pastor. Allow me just a few examples: I was not an experienced preacher, but Chuck Grossman, then the congregation's president, told me after a time that my sermons were getting better. I was grateful for his encouragement. Perhaps I was still in somewhat academic mode, but Kay Charon and Mim Edwins tolerated my reading theological tomes to them while they worked on the "Noah's Ark" newsletter. And I had no idea how to deal with seventh and eighth graders, but a number of school teachers came to my rescue and helped me develop an approach to confirmation classes that was a blessing to the students and their families, and not least of all to me.

It's a wonderful blessing to have served God's people at Trinity as their pastor. You all have a special place in my heart.

Editor's Note: Thanks Pastor David Mahsman for sharing your thoughts, often combined with humor to keep us smiling. Ah, but you did teach Confirmation; our John still remembers you teaching them the "Moonwalk" lol. At least you made it fun! I remember your dog sliding down the hall of the parsonage haha. You did good with the youth but it's always good to put the saints to work, too. Equipping us was a special part of your ministry; Evangelism calls were part of that training. Thanks for all your work you did with the Lutheran Witness over the years and then the tremendous job you did in Wittenberg, Germany.
