

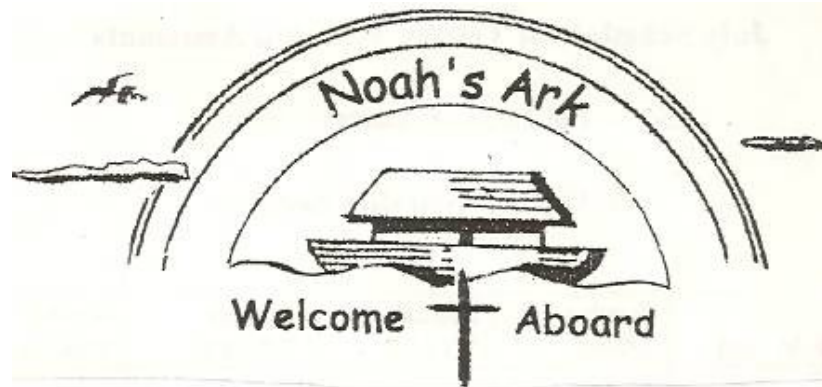

From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In case you weren't aware, we worship on Thursday Night. At the moment, we average about 3-5 families hearing God's word. During worship we're hearing about God and a new creation. New creation means a new life. A new life that God gives to us every day. Imagine having a new body everyday. Imagine you could do anything you want because you are given a new body. I would eat as much junk food and fast food as I could because I know by the end of the day, I'm getting a new body. Ah, that would be great but I don't think God had that in mind when He says "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a **new creation**. The old has passed away; behold, the **new** has come." 2 Corinthians 5:17

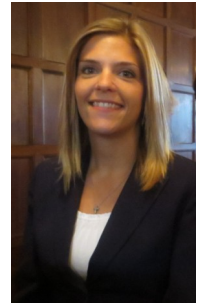

Pastor Travis would like to open the food pantry a second time during the month. If you are interested in helping please let Pastor know (probably the 1st Sat)

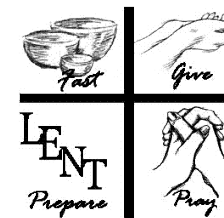


