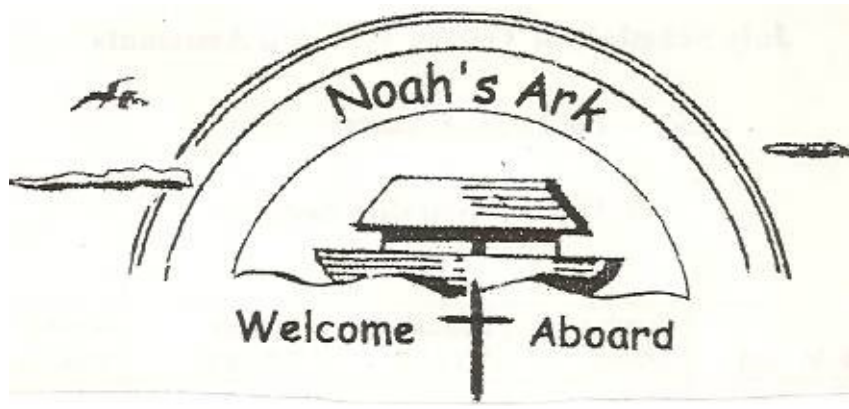

From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

31 “Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, **32** not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the Lord. **33** For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.” Jeremiah 31:31-33

Has anybody ever asked you where you are able to find texts about Christianity in the Old Testament? The Bible is pretty simple and laid out if you know where to look. Although, to know where to look is the question. First God has to point you in the right direction. Sometimes in the Old Testament, the direction might not actually point to the name Jesus. For example, you can find the word Messiah (the Christ, anointed), and in other areas you will find the Root of Jesse. Here's a great text in the Book of Jeremiah. This text resonates with a lot of people who believe in God. A text that doesn't state Jesus, the Christ or the anointed. This is a great promise and it holds a lot of weight in our lives. Even though you might not see the word Jesus, you can see the promise of God through Jesus.

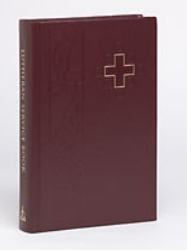
God makes this covenant with a specific reason. He needs a new covenant because the people of God keep breaking their end of it. God's covenant is a great contract with His people. A contract that's unbreakable from God's side of it. It's here in this text that God reminds you through Jeremiah, that the gift to believe comes from God. It's not by our own doing but by God's gift. As Jeremiah told the people of Israel, the day is coming. That day was when Jesus died on the cross for us. Our God now blesses us with His word by pouring it into our hearts. We are His people, a people that receives the wonderful grace of forgiveness. Through His word in our heart, we become a new creation through the power of the Holy Spirit. Now we are His people, **7** “I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the Lord your God,” Exodus 6:7. May God continue to remind us that we are his people and no one can take us away from Him. May God continue to strengthen our relationship with Him. Behold the days are coming when we will join God in the kingdom of Heaven.

I invite you to Holy Week Services. Hear what God did for YOU! Hear what God did to His own Son for YOU! Hear why God loves YOU! May God continue to make us His people in the name of Jesus.

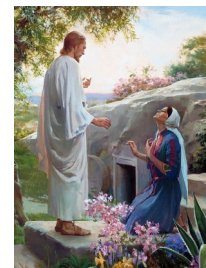

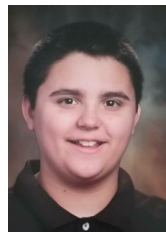

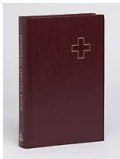

April Lenten Devotion by Deaconess Elect Phyllis Yee



*“And he said to all, “If anyone would come after me,
let him deny himself and take up his cross
daily and follow me.” – Luke 9:23*

We all have crosses that we have to carry throughout our daily lives. Do you think it's difficult to follow Jesus at times? As most of you know my father had the toes on his right foot amputated back in January. He has been recovering since then and has been feeling down on himself because he can't move around as he used to and needs assistance at times.

This heavy cross has been plaguing him and we've had several discussions on how he can pick up this burden and suffering and trust in the Lord and follow Him. Of course this isn't an easy task to do. Sometimes our crosses are so heavy we feel as if we can't afford to carry them any longer and forget to leave it all in God's hands and follow Him.

In Luke 9:23 Jesus says that if we want to come after Him, we must pick up our crosses and follow Him. Life never goes according to plan, if it did we would be the ones in control of it and we would have no need to follow Jesus. That isn't the reality we face as Christians. Life shows us that we need to follow Jesus and He tells us to do this in 3 steps.

The first step is looking beyond our emotions and circumstances and deny them, which is an extremely tough thing to do. The second is to take up our crosses and sins and stop wishing for everything to change, but instead bring our heavy burdens to Him to be forgiven. And the third step is that we are to simply follow Him and who He is.

Each day we are going to have to pick up that cross and do things that Christ has asked us to do. There will be days where it may seem like your cross is too heavy to bear, but the Lord will never give you more than you can handle. Always trust that God is with you every step of the way as you are carrying that cross throughout your life.

Prayer: Lord, the crosses we carry in our lives seem heavy at times but we know that is when we need You the most. We need to follow You and trust that You will help us carry that cross. We pray that throughout this Lenten season that You help and guide us to walk in Your footsteps. Thank you for always walking by our side. In Jesus' Name we pray. Amen!

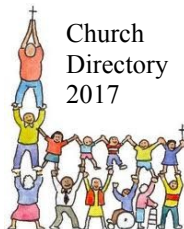
