

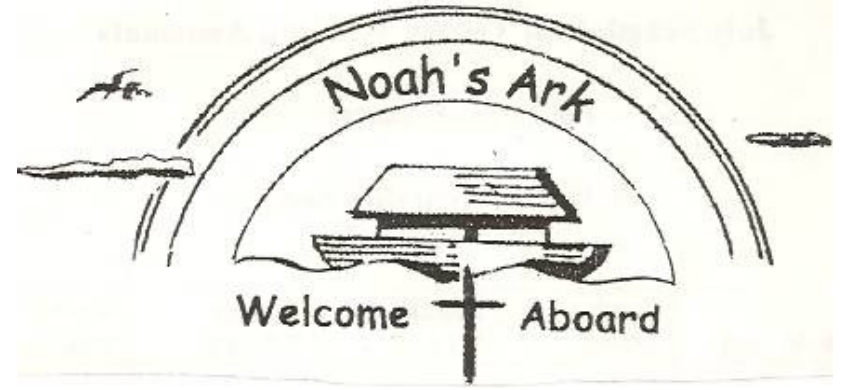

### From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In opposition to both these parties it has been unanimously taught by the other teachers of the Augsburg Confession that Christ is our righteousness not according to His divine nature alone, nor according to His human nature alone, but according to both natures; for He has redeemed, justified, and saved us from our sins as God and man, through His complete obedience; that therefore the righteousness of faith is the forgiveness of sins, reconciliation with God, and our adoption as God's children only on account of the obedience of Christ, which through faith alone, out of pure grace, is imputed for righteousness to all true believers, and on account of it they are absolved from all their unrighteousness. (Solid Declaration of the Formula of Concord, III. The Righteousness of Faith section 4)

Faith is an interesting topic for Lutherans. What exactly is faith? Is it something that you can hold? Is it something that you can wrap in a present and give it to people? During the 500th year of the Reformation, we will be hearing words like Faith Alone, Scripture Alone and Grace Alone. Why do we need it? Jesus' death should be enough. Now we need to believe. Faith teaches us everything that God did for us through Jesus Christ alone. Faith to know that Jesus is the Son of God and the Son of Man.

When we have faith in Christ for what He did for us, we also have faith to be God's children and be obedient to Christ. Faith is more than just believing. It's only the start! Living in righteousness works for us than not living in it. When we are living by our faith in righteousness we build on the wonderful relationship that God wanted for us since the very beginning.

Every day as a Pastor, I am grateful for the wonderful gift of faith. It's awesome to know that I can come to God, ask for his forgiveness and then worship with my fellow brothers and sisters in Christ. I fail at obedience and living righteousness. However through faith, I can achieve all of it through Christ who strengthens me. Faith is a wonderful gift that God gives to you all.
