

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

From the Pastor

5 The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!"
6 And the Lord said, "If you had faith like a grain of mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you. Luke 17:5-6

When I hear "Increase our Faith!" I think this should be our theme and our statement at Trinity. Every day this month, when you go to church, you could go to another member or to Pastor and say: Increase our faith! As your Pastor, I would be delighted to hear those words.

Who wouldn't be delighted to hear those three words. God would love to hear those words come from our lips and probably pleased to know His children want to grow. As Christians, we should grow in our faith. Now is the time to do so. People and the world are turning away from God.

Today, to have a conversation about faith is very minor. People do not want to hear how we increase faith. Instead they want to know how to decrease their faith. Even God's own people do not want to know how to increase but just give enough. It's not just our faith that we want to increase, it's the work of God. Martin Luther said "Do not think lightly of faith. It is a work that is of all works the most excellent and the most difficult. Through it alone you will be saved, even though you were obliged to do without all other works. For it is the world of God, not of man, as Paul teaches (Eph 1:19). The other works He performs with our co-operation and through us; this alone He works within us and without our co-operation (sine nobis)"1

With increased faith, comes increased works. Faith isn't idle nor does it stay still. It grows everyday and our actions grow with it. Our faith leads us to do the will of God and His work. Therefore, when I hear increase our faith from you, I can say, we have some wonderful work we can do together for the sake of His kingdom. There is a world out there that has fallen away and there are those who have not heard the wonderful news of Jesus. Let's share it as Luther shared the Word during His time and as the apostles shared it during their time. Let's say "Increase our Faith!" together.


MISSIONARY TO PREACH AT TRINITY


