



From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This month marks the 500th anniversary of the Lutheran Reformation. For the next three monthly newsletters, I will focus on the 3 Solas of the Lutheran Church. Solas in Latin means Solely alone. They are Scripture Alone, Faith Alone and Grace Alone. This month, we will take a look at Scripture Alone.

At times, we might take Scripture for granted. Sometimes people only use it to prove their point. LOOK SEE - Jesus Said This!!!! or LOOK did Jesus really SAY THAT? STOP READING THE LAW or Jesus LOVED ALL PEOPLE. Scripture becomes a pawn for people to use. Even the church is made up of these types of people. So why celebrate Scripture alone? We as God's people have to trust in His Word. His word is there to teach you about God's works, God's love and God's plan for all people He has created. 16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness. 2 Timothy 3:16

God's Word is alive! He has breathed out this wonderful text to teach us about one thing, why He loves you and what He did to ensure that love would come true. Well, maybe that's two things but you get the point. St. Paul says the righteous shall live by faith - we learn how to live in a righteous life by reading the Scriptures. 


## Monday Evening Bible Study with Deaconess Elect Phyllis Yee

**Women's Bible Study** meets Thursdays at 1 PM. Studying the Gospel of John - Leader: Pastor Travis in the Fellowship Room.


**All welcome** on Thursday, Sept.14th at 7 PM Pastor Travis will lead the Alpha Series in the Upper Room. Dinner will be served.




