






What Trinity Lutheran Church Means to Me

It has been 30 years since we attended Trinity Church. Much has happened since.



Growing up in a Christian family I knew the importance of Proverbs 22:6 “Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.” When my daughter was five I found myself looking for a church where she could attend Sunday School. Having just moved to Glen Cove from Queens I visited a few difference churches in Glen Cove but never felt quite at home. I then found Trinity Church and felt very much at home right away. My daughter and I started attending Trinity and not before long I was involved teaching Sunday School and VBS.

In order to become a member I had to take a membership class. At that time David Mahsman was the pastor and he agreed to have the membership class at our house. My husband had no interest in attending church but for some reason he decided to participate in our group Pastor Mahsman just read certain passages from the Bible, words of truth that sparked an interest in a man who had never been exposed to God’s word.

Some years later we moved to Texas and my husband decided to go to seminary. He has traveled all over the US to minister to prisoners in jails and prisons and currently teaches a few times a week at the county jail where we live. Romans 10:17 says “So faith comes from hearing and hearing from the Word of Christ.” We can testify to the truth in that verse!

My daughter received her education from a Christian university, met her husband there and are now raising three young children who attend Sunday School where they are taught biblical principles that will guide them and keep them on the right track in life.

I believe this all started as I listened to that small voice to enroll my 5-year old daughter in Sunday School at Trinity Church.

Thanks Eva, great sharing! Eva & Ken attended Leisure Week 2 at Tuscarora this summer. Then they traveled to CT to visit with former Trinity Superintendent Dick & Kathy Nordstrom. There’s a song we sing “Friends are friends forever, if the Lord’s the Lord of them.” I still remember Melissa in the pageant of Christmas around the World with the St Lucia headdress of candles. Beautiful memories of all. Much love!




