



May Devotion by Deaconess Elect Phyllis Yee

"Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." And he said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation." – Luke 11:1-4 Prayer is powerful. One of my favorite Bible verses in regards to prayer is: "Pray without ceasing." from 1 Thessalonians 5:17. Prayer is an extremely personal thing in our lives. It's a time where God is the focus of our lives and the center of our conversation. You can talk to God everywhere and at anytime. There are many opportunities throughout our day where we can just converse with Him, whether it be during your morning drive, while cleaning your house, or before you fall asleep at night. I usually pray while I'm running or driving alone because there are no other distractions around me. I can share with God the aspects of my life that are concerning, giving me anxiety, or give thanks to Him for what He's blessed me with. Prayer keeps Him in the center of everything we do. God answers our prayers, but not always in the way we pictured having our prayers answered. The other day I was researching a few blogs about prayer and came across this thought-provoking quote, "If you can figure out how God is going to do something, that's not how He is going to do it." If we knew how our prayers were going to be answered we would be the one in control of our lives, not God. Life can be messy and sometimes it can seem like it's falling to pieces. It's during those times that we can turn to God and pray for Him to guide and help us through it. We take our problems to God, leave it with Him and have the faith and trust that He will take care of it however He sees fit for us.

Prayer does not have to be complicated! Just stop, look and listen. God wants us to **stop** everything we are doing and just focus on Him. He wants us to **look** at His Word concerning the situation we are going through and ask for His guidance on how to handle it. And finally God wants us to **listen** and be still and wait for an answer, it might not be the answer we want but He will provide an answer at some point. It's just that simple! What is one thing that you need to pray to God for today?

Prayer: Father you are our Good Father. Guide us to be able to tell you all of our problems and give it up to You. Help us to stop, look and listen while praying to You. Thank you for always listening to our prayers and being faithful with the answers You provide. In Jesus' Name. Amen!
