Plans are in the making for a German Worship Service the second Sunday in December at 2 PM.

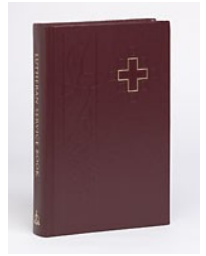
