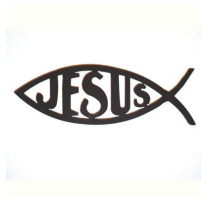

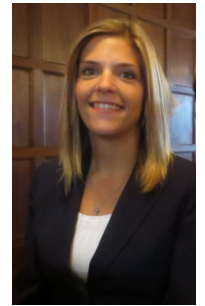

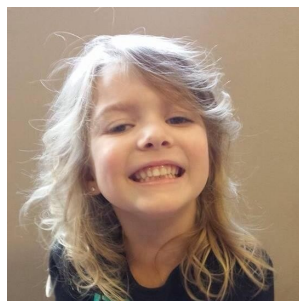
### ***It has pleased Almighty God to call home to Himself Mary Compton, 87 years old, Trinity's former Organist on January 5th.***

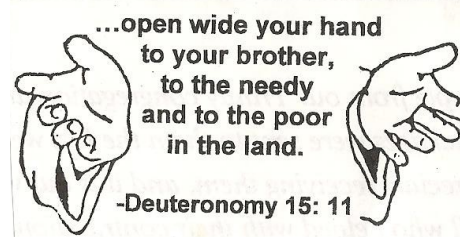
We thank God that Mary touched our lives at Trinity. She is survived by her two sons, Scott and Steven.

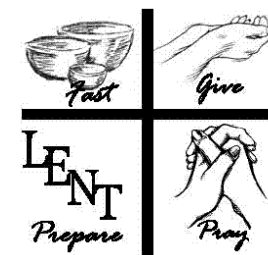

Great job all who helped on clean up day. Joan Pedigo for cleaning the carpets and Lauren MacDonald for washing the aisle and pew floors.

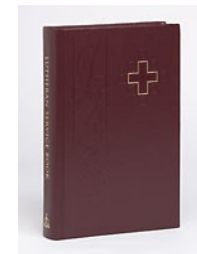
