

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

He Is Risen! He Is Risen! He Is Risen Indeed, Alleluia.

Now that that's been said, please don't tell anyone. That's right, I said it. Keep it to yourself and keep silent. Don't go rushing out of your chair to tell someone that Jesus rose from the dead. The same Jesus who died three days earlier. Jesus died for others and not just for myself. Isn't that what Easter is all about?

People gather together, the pews become full, you dress up, you pick up your nice flowers and then the day is over. We move on. We can now wait another 378 more days until the next Easter. Therefore, while Easter is here right now, what are you going to do? Let's focus on you? What kind of action will you be doing? Are you going to keep silent, stay in your seat or move with the excitement of Jesus being raised from the dead.

In case you can't make a decision of who you might be, let's use an example. Look to the Gospel reading for Easter morning. From Luke 24, after hearing the good news, the women ran to the room. They rushed to the room where the disciples were hiding. They told the disciples and only 2, just 2 out of 11 ran to the tomb. The others stayed behind. Therefore, which party are you? I pray that we're not the party that just stayed behind. I hope and pray that as you're reading this you're thinking I'm not going to keep silent. Instead, I'm going to tell the world, my neighbor, my friend or a member who stopped going to church, that Jesus rose from the dead. That Jesus died for them and that we got to hear the wonderful news of the resurrection at church.

At church, we will hear why God loves us so much that we're too excited just to keep it to ourselves. The women couldn't contain the excitement and they went to tell the disciples. We shouldn't contain the excitement in knowing what God did for us. As God's children, we shouldn't stay silent or just stay in our seats. Allow God to move you to see His work and to tell others about Jesus.


