

Dear Brothers and Sister in Christ,

As a Pastor, I've talked to a lot of people. Most of the time that's what pastors do, they talk. On that rare occasion, they might even listen. I listen to people tell me their story. Usually the story might depend on the set of mood they are feeling. If they're feeling good, then the mood is lifting and you see smiles. Although, the opposite can take effect, too, for whatever the reason (health, jobless, anxiety, depression, being a caretaker, etc) I can hear a different tone. A tone that makes anybody wonder, why would God allow His people to feel such pain physically, emotionally, mentally and even spiritually.

That question is very common. To relay the correct answer, I have to look to God to help during those situations. It's easy to say to look toward God but it's faith to understand His words. We have to listen to what God has to say during those situations to help us change how we think or feel. Isaiah 41:10 tell us "10 fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand." This verse is for everybody. It doesn't have to be for a certain reason. I know that when we are down and when the tone isn't right, we can rely on this verse.

Being a Pastor doesn't mean I will have all the right answers (which I don't), I can only rely on God and to relay God's word, love and care back to His flock. As God's flock, God is there to listen. He is the ultimate listener. He knows how to listen and to hear us when we are in need. People will say God never talks or answers back. He does talk and answer. He talks through His word. He tells us not to be dismayed and that He will be our strength when we are weak. If we can't hold on to God, God will hold on to us. His word is a word of comfort. We find joy in His word when we are weak, feeling grief, anxiety or depression. God lifts you out of the deep hole we find ourselves. His hand makes us righteous.

My brothers and sisters, as God prepares all of you to finish out the season of Lent, do not be dismayed by anything this world has to offer. Remember, God's strength lies in the Son of God who gave His life in order that we will have life on the last day. Rely on His eternal strength.

May God comfort their hearts with His presence and peace.






