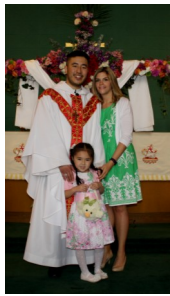

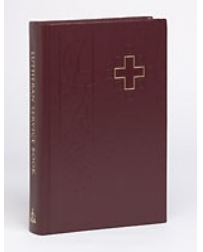

This Trinity church isn't just a building, it's a people, people whom I love deeply including missing those who have gone on before me. It's the place where my nephews were raised in the precious name of Jesus.

Now I have been given an opportunity to be your Trinity church secretary and have become an 'official member' which gives me new ways to get to know you and at the same time I am able to serve you.
