



From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

He is Risen! It's a great statement. I love this statement. Everything that Jesus did was completed on Easter Sunday. Let's proclaim to others about the Risen Savior. Even though its such a common statement for us, it's not the first words said that morning. Read what Mary said: "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him." John 20:2. They weren't even thinking that Jesus rose from the dead. Instead, they were worried that someone might've actually have stolen Jesus' body. If that were the case, then they weren't able to give Jesus a proper burial. Imagine, if someone stole the body of your relative, friend or coworker. How would you react? You wouldn't be reacting with a happy statement or even thinking about what Jesus said to them. *31* And he began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes and be killed, and after three days rise again. Mark 8:31

Early Easter morning wasn't very kind to Mary. They sure didn't have nice flowers on the altar like we do. It was definitely the complete opposite. They intended to give Jesus a proper burial with spices and fragrance. They couldn't do it on Friday because of the Sabbath. Sunday morning was the only day and now the body was gone. They feared and worried that Jesus suffered a great death and now couldn't even receiver a proper funeral. Thanks be to God, that we don't have to worry nor fear because we know the real reason why the tomb was empty. It was God's act in resurrecting the Son of Man for the world to see the wonderful gift of life.

On Easter morning, we give thanks knowing that the words He is Risen is a great proclamation to the millions of people who haven't heard the words. As God's children we know the real reason for the words. We understand what they truly represent. Some might say it because it's Easter. WE say it because we receive the whole gift. His Death and His Resurrection. We no longer have to worry about Jesus. The battle has been won. He has appeared to you as your Risen Savior. 13 They said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid him." 14 Having said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing, but she did not know that it was Jesus. 15 Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" Supposing him to be the gardener, she said to him, "Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away." 16 Jesus said to her, "Mary." She turned and said to him in Aramaic, "Rabboni!" (which means Teacher). God has called you. May we be excited as Mary was on Easter morning. He is Risen! Pastor Travis


