Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

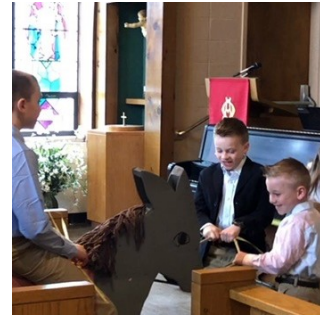

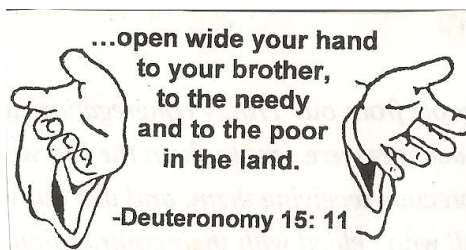
FOOD PANTRY AND THRIFT SHOP

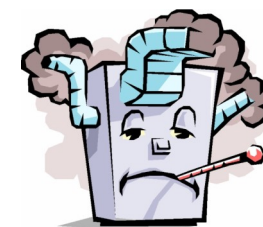
