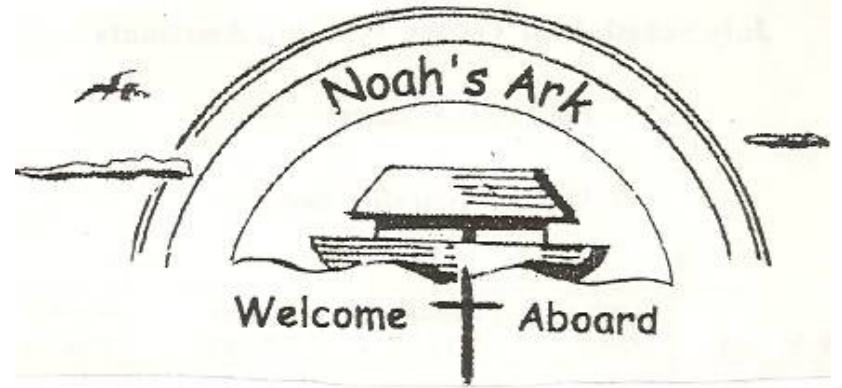

Noah's Ark

June 2018



The other day during an opportunity to serve God's people and God's Kingdom of Power (Food Pantry and Thrift Shop), a certain topic came up. When we were students we would receive new books for the school year. It was our text books that we would learn from during the year. A brand new book with a vast amount of knowledge was at our fingertips. It was exciting for a few hours until you actually had to use it and read it. Whatever the case might have been, the first thing you did at home was to put a cover on it. Usually it was a brown paper cover. I found a picture of what it looked like back in the day.

Amazing that we thought that a simple brown piece of paper could cover our books. It didn't matter if we tossed it, drew on the covers and the sorts, it would save the book. Wouldn't it be great if we could cover ourselves from the world? We are made new through the blood of Jesus Christ. We have a new life through God's gift of Faith. With this new life, God wants to protect us.



10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. **11** Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.

Ephesians 6:10-11

God's armor protects your whole body. Just as the book cover protects the whole book from markers, crayons and spilled milk.

Fathers be the kind of believer that you hope your children will become as you walk in His footprints and as your children walk in yours. A word to the wise is sufficient...1st Chronicles 28... hear King David as he shares wisdom with his son Solomon. David had it in his heart to build a temple for the Lord for the ark of the covenant of the Lord and for the footstool of God. But God had a different plan because David was a man of war and shed blood; so God chose Solomon to build it saying in v6 ..."It is your son Solomon who shall build My house and My courts; for I have chosen him to be My son, and I will be his Father. v7 Moreover I will establish his kingdom forever, if he is steadfast to observe My commandments and My judgments, as it is this day." More words of wisdom to his son...v9 "As for you, my son Solomon, know the God of your father, and serve Him with a loyal heart and with a willing mind; for the Lord searches all hearts and understands all the intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will cast you off forever." Then, as a father would, he made all the preparations for his son to build the temple. He wanted his son to accomplish this great feat for God. David, according to God's Spirit. planned everything for the temple—the blueprints, the gold, silver, wood—he had it all laid out for his son to build. v19 "All this," said David, "the Lord made me to understand in writing, by His hand upon me, all the works of these plans. "And his final words to his son before building the temple were... v20 and David said to his son Solomon, "be strong and of good courage, and do it; do not fear nor be dismayed, for the Lord God – my God – will be with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you, until you have finished all the work for the service of the house of the Lord." What better example could we follow for our children than that of King David, a man after God's own heart! God will accomplish His will through us and through our children. We are His hands and His feet to do His bidding.

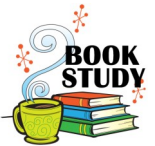

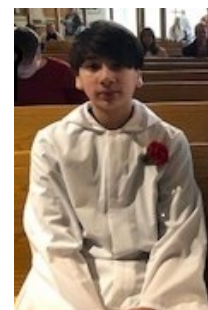
Warren. More info to come as soon as we hear. Please keep Warren in prayer as he adjusts to his new living quarters.

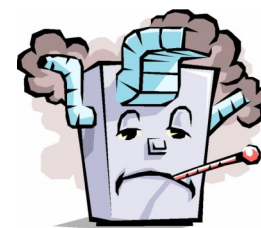

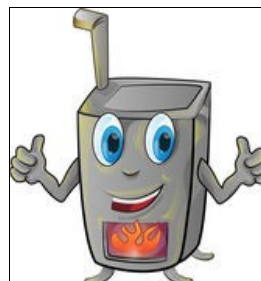
