To My brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Seasons come and go, the Epiphany season will end on March 5 (Fat Tuesday) and we'll enter into the Lenten Season. A season in which we are to prepare for Jesus to hang on an old rugged cross. A cross that will be the symbol of God's love and promise of eternal life. How will you prepare for this season? Will you make this an easy season or take on a more difficult aspect to it? Your journey during Lent will all depend on what you make of it. Most people will take the easiest route because that's what they know how to do, while others will take a different route. The easiest route is do nothing during Lent. Just go on with your normal every day activities. While the harder aspect of this season is to give up something.


Do you know why you're suppose to give up something? Most people take this journey because that's what the church has taught that it's a requirement. For example, you need to give up meat, give up TV, give up food or don't give up anything. Did you know that even before Lent starts, there's a specific day just to eat a lot of food. Traditionally, we have always called it Fat Tuesday. It's the day before Ash Wednesday. A day of eating as much as you can because during Lent you would fast for 40 days. Fill your tummies up because you would be sacrificing and fasting during Lent. We tend to think that when we "sacrifice" or "fast" from something, it's good. While it might be good, we have to understand why we do it.

"For I desire steadfast love and not sacrifice, the knowledge of God rather than burnt offerings." Hosea 6:6 ESV.

We want to give up something for God in order for it to help us focus more on God. When we give up something, our attention should be focused on God. As Jesus stated we shall not live on bread alone but on the Word of God. By not focusing on a specific item, we can show steadfast love for God and for our neighbors, that's the ultimate sacrifice (gift) we can give. Just as Jesus was sacrificed for us, it was the ultimate gift of love that God gave to His people. The hardest journey for Jesus was to travel to the cross on Mount Calvary in order to save the world from sin, death and the devil. Therefore, whatever journey you take during Lent make sure the main purpose of it is to hear, read and learn about Jesus. Sacrifice something but fill it with God's steadfast love and care.

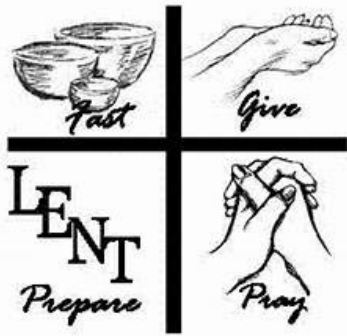

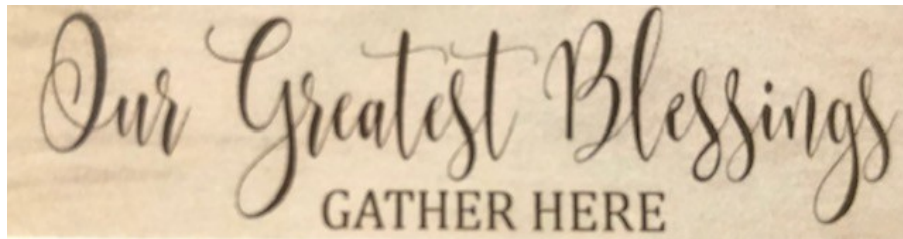
