



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Look at St. Paul and his letter to the church of Philippi. 20 as it is my eager expectation and hope that I will not be at all ashamed, but that with full courage now as always Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death. Through his faith in God, no amount of shame will ever fall upon Paul.

Paul's expectation is to always be in God's grace and in the fellowship with the LORD and King. No matter the source, outcome or scenery, Paul will be in Christ as Christ is in him. Our only expectation shouldn't be what can God do for me. He already did it on the cross. The only expectation that we can look for is when will Christ call us home?






