

Happy 99th Anniversary to Trinity Lutheran Church First Worship Service August 20, 1920

Called Home by the Lord

Our beloved Rev Herbert Kern was called Home by the Lord on August 24th at 102 years old. He had missed his beloved Alma so much who he was married to for 66 years. He planted and shepherded Calvary, East Meadow for 32 years and was Chaplain to the EM Fire Dept for over 50 years. After retiring from Calvary, he served St Paul's, Amityville until his passing. He also led services at Gilgo Beach every Labor Day and enjoyed that. In a phone conversation he told me he exercises every day for 10 minutes on his bike and says 11 Bible verses every day. He said he had to sit to preach now at Amityville but that it's a fact that Jesus sat as he preached. Also mentioning that in the ancient world of the apostles only 10% of the people could read and write so they read the scriptures to them and that a good reader could add inflection and be dramatic about it. Dramatic Pastor Kern was as he preached to us so often at Trinity. Pure and simple, 3 basic points to each sermon and you brought them home with you every time, plus a Bible verse written out on an index card to boot. His favorite verses Genesis 12:2, Isaiah 43:4, 1st Thessalonians 5:18 and Romans 8:28 were written on his memorial card -he'd want you to look them up! A service was held at Calvary, East Meadow on Aug. 31st where his son-in-law Pastor Robert Kuppler gave the sermon "Live and Learn with Herbie Kern" and the eulogy was given by his granddaughter who gave insights into her childhood growing up with them. We are grateful to God for his faithful servant and for Pastor Kern's guidance to Trinity. Our sympathy and love to children Tom, Lois and Dan and families. "His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a few things, I will set you over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord'." Matthew 25:21





Called Home by the Lord


