"Walking in God's Footsteps"



There's a song we taught the children at VBS years ago, "I want to Walk in the Footsteps of Jesus," He is the true and living way! Ephesians 6:15 tells us "...and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace."

There have been so many great witnesses at Trinity over the years who walked in the footsteps of Jesus and followed His example but the one who stands out and comes to mind when reading the above verse is Mrs Dottie French-Kossmann.

Dottie was a great woman of God, a best friend and sister-in-Christ to so many at Trinity. She named the praise team "One Heart!" One of her favorite praise songs was "Our God Reigns" - How lovely on the mountains are the feet of Him who brings Good News, good news; Announcing peace, proclaiming news of happiness: Our God reigns, our God reigns! (Leonard Smith 1979). Her favorite Bible verse was Isaiah 40:31 "But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint." That's what Dottie was all about, sharing the gospel of Jesus with all she could. She taught our Sunday morning Bible class and put so much into the preparation to help us to be more like Jesus, to better understand the truths of Scripture and apply them to our lives. She started Adam's Ribs, a group for young women who would meet at church in the afternoon with their children with babysitting provided. They did a Bible study and she taught them to be Jesus' examples by serving; the gals would prepare meals for the sick and those in need after hospitalization. Being a recipient of those meals made me feel very loved and cared about by my church. Dottie would encourage all to go to Tuscarora Inn on the Delaware River for retreat; a quiet place to concentrate on our relationship with the Lord, to draw nearer to God, with wonderful speakers and teachers plus a lot of good Christian fellowship and fun at meals and free time. In closing, we can learn a lot from Dottie, she listened for the Lord's direction, prayed and read her Bible regularly, and then obediently followed His leading, thinking of ways she could help others to draw closer to their Savior. What is God saving to us? How is he telling us to help our members grow closer to him and in fellowship with one another? What can I do? Let us listen for his voice and follow in obedience and walk in his footsteps. Pray and share your ideas with Pastor Travis or a Council Member. Everyone of us in the church has a spiritual gift to use for His glory and we also have been given talents to share! God created the church to worship him, to be ministered to, to build each other up into the fullness of Christ and share His message with the world. Help us.
