Re: Church Council—Romy Bennett who has been serving on Council as Council Secretary has asked to step down as she has accepted a position at Locust Valley Schools that will be demanding of her time as Union President of Teachers and Staff. We thank Romy for all her input on Council and work on fundraisers such as the successful Pancake Breakfasts. May God bless her new endeavor.

The Voters approved the election of Sonja Konzet-Meenan and Bill Charon to serve as Council Members for 2021.

Sunday School—Sarah Blough has volunteered to lead Sunday School starting in the summer with a VBS type theme to reach out to our children and others in the community to join in and hopefully eventually attend our church. One week will be teaching, a second week with crafts to bring the teaching home, a third week with a play or musical and the fourth week to perform in church. Sarah will need our participation and help so please keep her in prayer and be willing to help.

The Voters approved a motion for the time of the church service to be changed to 10 AM rather than 9:30 to give the families with young children more time to get ready for church. It will be on a trial basis for now starting in May.

Press Conference—Related to our 100th Anniversary, Tim Charon has contacted local officials—Congressmen, Representatives, Newspapers—to organize the date for the Press Conference in front of Trinity. A theme, a banner and a Go Fund Me campaign is being created. We want to emphasize Trinity's important role in the community as well as problems that the Covid pandemic has created for religious institutions. We will let you know of the date and time.

The Voters approved a local Pentecostal church to use our undercroft for worship 2 times a week on Sundays from 2-4 PM and on Wednesdays from 7-9 PM starting in May. There will be about 30 people and the kitchen will not be used except to make coffee. A donation of up to \$2,000/month will be made. They are providing proof of Insurance.
