*What a beautiful witness Christie was, the most sweet and caring person, gifted in voice and talent in playing piano, organ and keyboard; a concerned Christian, an encourager, never a bad word to say about anyone, but only uplifting others in words and prayer; still anxious to learn—she was always taking sermon notes. She was an inspiration to all her family, friends and to so many singers and musicians, she will be missed by everyone.*

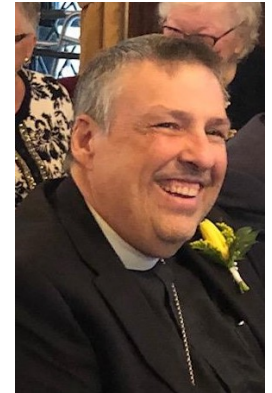
### Called Home by the Lord...

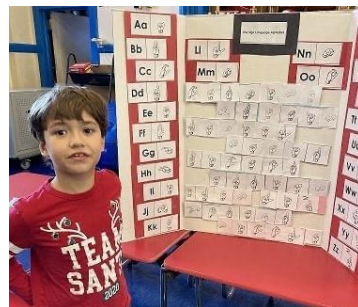

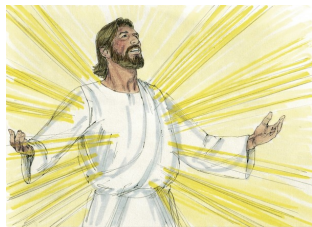
