Pentecost-the Coming of the Holy Spirit

Pentecost, also known as **Whitsunday**, is observed on the seventh Sunday after Easter and 10 days after Ascension. The name comes from the Greek word "pentekoste" which means fiftieth as Pentecost Sunday takes place on the 50th day of Easter.

In Acts 2 in the New Testament, the Holy Spirit comes to the apostles on Pentecost Sunday to fulfill Jesus' words that they would receive power from the Holy Spirit to glorify God's name to all nations. The Holy Spirit allowed the apostles to speak in other languages, and they started preaching the word of Jesus to the Jews who were in Jerusalem for the feast of Shavuot (also known as the Feast of Weeks or Pentecost - in this case, meaning seven weeks since Passover). As a result, we, the church and body of Christ, are called to bear witness to all nations through the power of the Holy Spirit and with courage to glorify the name of God!

Pentecost is found in the Old Testament Scripture as a Jewish holiday. Pentecost was a Jewish festival that happened 50 days after Passover, which celebrated Israel's deliverance from Egypt and the celebration of God giving the Law to Moses on Mt. Sinai. Earlier, Pentecost was a time to celebrate the first fruits of the wheat harvest. For Christians now, Pentecost is the birthday of the Christian Church!

Thank you God for the Holy Spirit and for the power that lives within us through the gifts You have given us! Help us to serve You and Your Church and glorify You in all our efforts. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

An Introduction as we Welcome **Rev. Anthony Giordano** to Trinity as Interim Pastor in Pastor Travis' Absence




