







**On Sunday, September 25th** after worship **Ted Marohn from Janney** came to Trinity to update us on our investment accounts and make a plan going forward re our Exxon stock bequeathed to us by Gladys Thoma. The consensus of those present was to retain 30% of the Exxon stock and sell 70% to be invested in a diversified fund. Our thanks to Ted for all his help.



**On Sunday, October 16th at the scheduled Voters Body Meeting** Bette Lippmann and Kay Charon were voted back on to Council; Bette as co-Treasurer with Bill Charon and Kay as Financial Secretary. The Voters also approved the final disposition which called for selling 70% of the Exxon stock and purchasing the American Moderate Growth Diversified Fund. It was noted in the financial report that a combination of a successful golf outing, the rental of our basement to Iglesia Pentecostal Church and savings resulting from Pastor's medical being paid for by the Army and also saving on salary while he was away at Chaplaincy training, has been a significant help to the congregation.

### ***Advent Theme: Wait Upon the Lord!***

***The last Sunday in November is the 1st Sunday in Advent. Services will be on Thursdays at 7 PM.***

***Week 1:*** Wait Upon the Lord with Faith (Galatians 3:8): Abraham and Sarah waited with faith for the birth of their son, Isaac, and we wait with faith for the birth of God's Son, Jesus, trusting that He will come at Christmas to save all people.

***Week 2:*** Wait Upon the Lord with Hope (Psalm 130:5): The prophet Isaiah declared the coming of the Lord, which gave the people of Israel hope for the future. We wait with hope for the future because we know what the future holds—a Savior.

***Week 3:*** Wait Upon the Lord with Rejoicing (Isaiah 25:9): Elizabeth rejoiced as she waited for the coming of her son, John the Baptist. And Mary rejoiced as she waited for the birth of her son, Jesus. In the same manner we rejoice as we wait for the coming of the Son of God.

***Week 4:*** Wait Upon the Lord with Gratitude (Psalm 9:1): Zechariah's waiting days for John the Baptist's birth were filled with great gratitude for the Lord's promise about to be fulfilled. In these remaining waiting days before our Savior's birth, we are ever more grateful for the arrival of the Promised One.




