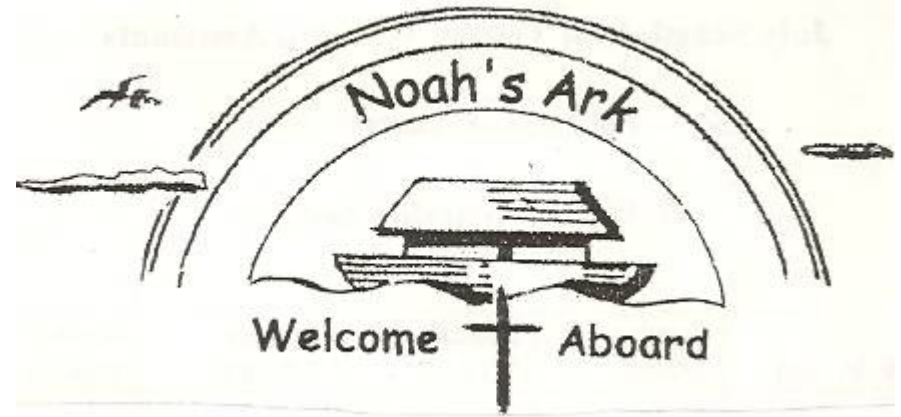

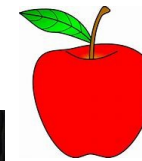

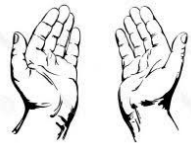


The Food Pantry will be open on Saturday 10/15 at 9:30 AM and Wednesdays from 6-7 PM with Hospital volunteers manning it.
