

From the Pastor



On the 21st of August, I stepped into the sanctuary of Trinity for Sunday Worship for the first time in three months. It was an incredible sight to see the Cross hanging on the wall. A presence that reminds me that no matter who walks through those doors, Christ is the center. People will pass through the doors, sit, and leave, but the one consistent foundation is Jesus Christ. It does not matter the pastor, the leaders, volunteers, or the people; the Word of Christ must always be the same.

As God's children, we are finishing the church year, and we must remind ourselves why we are here. Christ is an excellent reminder of why we attend Trinity. We step through the doors not because of the beauty or activities but due to the Cross. God reminds us why we are there. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. 49 But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great."

Brothers and Sisters, continue to build a strong foundation in Jesus. Storms come and go, but that does not mean our church will fall. However, the foundation can weaken when we allow other things to interfere with it. We cannot build up our church if our foundation is shaky. Before we can build our church, we must build ourselves. Challenge yourself with God's word and look at the Cross hanging on Trinity's wall behind the altar.




Women's News...
