

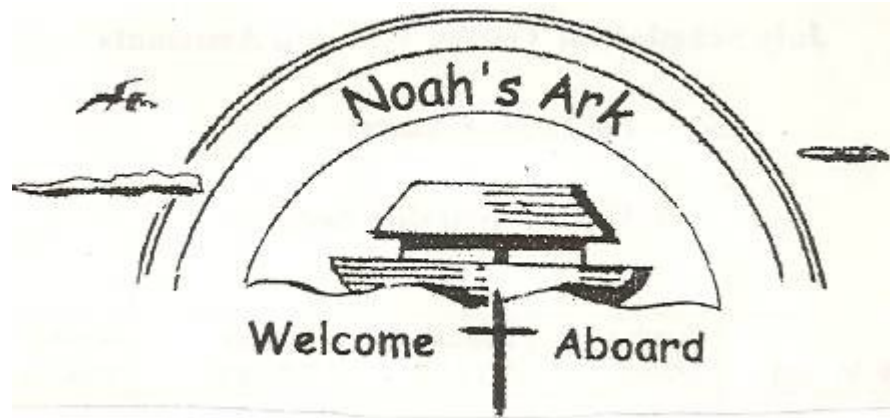

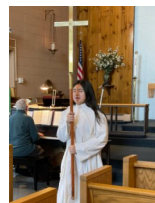

English Handbell and Chime Choirs

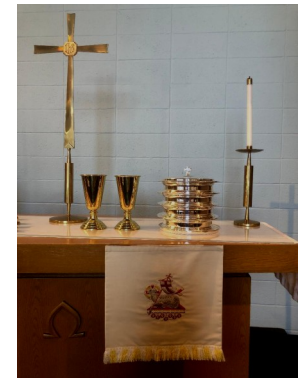
If interested in ringing English Handbells or chimes for the children, please speak with Kay Charon 516-507-4845 and we will set up a rehearsal day and time.
