From the Pastor



Compassion. Do you have it? Can you answer it? Is it easy or hard to answer? There are only two answers, yes or no. Before you answer it, though, what is compassion? Compassion is helping and giving to people in need. Are you a compassionate person looking for a reward or recognition? The answer should be no; we do not do it for the prize or award. Instead, God calls us to be compassionate in his letter -

12 Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, 13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive."

As God's chosen people, we belong to a different group than with people of the world. This group is here because God separates His people from the blood of Christ. We put on all of God's love, compassion, joy, and care for the people of this world. The same love that He placed Jesus on the cross is the same love we share via our actions with others. Actions that do not look inwardly but outwardly. Actions that people can see every day through spiritual worship. We do not care how we look because all others see Jesus. We do not watch for recognition because all others will see Jesus Christ. Compassion for our neighbor is the same compassion Jesus had for all people.

Mark 6:34 "When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had **compassion** on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. And he began to teach them many things." Are you a compassionate person? What is your answer?


Hearts Journey


