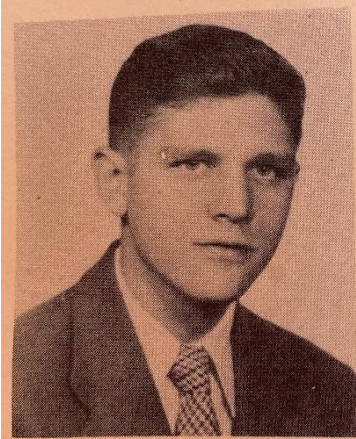
FRANK UHENDORF
